To allow for the success of the lower grades (K-2) with the Accelerated Reading Program we will not count how many points but how many tests they have taken and passed (25 tests passed = 25 pts). This is largely due to the amount of points the lower grade books are awarded (.5 verses 3-15 for upper grades) for AR. At the present rate it makes it almost impossible for most of the K-2 to reach the 25-100 points needed for school wide recognition. If, however, a child in the lower grades is reading the higher level books (which are worth more points) and is able to maintain the original point system, then we will use that system.
