### **IMPORTANT NEWS FROM OUR OFFICE!!!!**

**APPLY NOW FOR TUITION  
ASSISTANCE:** With the help of  
the Barry Robinson Foundation  
and other generous donors, CTK  
has been able to dedicate over  
\$60,000 in tuition assistance  
each year. To be considered for  
tuition assistance the SSS forms  
must be completed by the end of  
March. This has to be done  
each year. If  
you are presently receiving as-  
sistance you must fill out the re-  
quired paperwork for the upcom-  
ing year. If you fail to do this,  
you will not be able to receive  
assistance. **We consider each  
applicant on a first come first  
serve basis** and this year due to  
the economy we are being asked  
for assistance by more families  
than ever. The first two weeks in  
April we will make the determina-  
tion for assistance from the re-  
ports we receive from SSS.

### **DIOCESE SPONSORED FINANCIAL ASSISTANCE:**

Last week you received an e-  
mail regarding the DIOCESE's  
new financial aid source, The

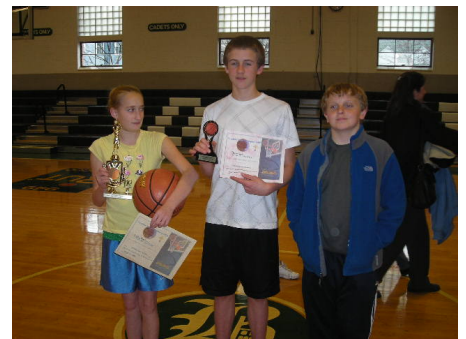
Eggxtreme Fun!
