DIOCESE SPONSORED FINANCIAL ASSISTANCE:

Just a few reminders about applying for Financial Aid through the McMahon Parater Foundation, the Diocese of Richmond's tuition assistance fund. Please remember:

1. On-line applications are available at www.factstuitionaid.com <<http://www.factstuitionaid.com/>> . Paper applications can be obtained from Mrs. Kallenbach in the CTK Development Office
2. Applications and supporting documentation are due by **May 1st**.
3. The following information is required in order for FACTS to process your family applications:
 - * Completed on-line or paper application
 - * Payment of \$20 application from the family (not individual student, aid is applied by family)
 - * Copies of your 2007 tax return including all schedules
 - * Copies of your 2008 W2 for both spouses applying for aid
 - * Copies of supporting documentation for Social Security Income, Welfare, Child Support, Food Stamps, Workers Comp, and TANF.
 - * Send the supporting documentation directly to FACTS. Christ the King School cannot accept the supporting documentation.
