Nurse's Notes: READ THIS!!!!

All rising 6th graders MUST have TDAP immunization prior to Aug 24th with documentation for health record or they will NOT be admitted to school on Aug 25th.

All kindergartners MUST have a physical exam, updated immunizations and TB test prior to Aug 24th or they will NOT be admitted to school on Aug 25th.

All medications must be taken at home at the end of school and new ones provided with child's name on label in the Fall. This includes new paperwork-allergy, asthma, and over the counter meds, i.e. tylenol, ibuprofen, benadryl and motrin. New med forms will be available when meds are picked up on last day of school.
