Again, there are no exceptions to our Bingo policy. Twenty hours of the annual required thirty service hours must be BINGO hours. If you have missed a session, you need to contact me for a make-up assignment.

C.T.K. SPELLCHECK FUND RAISER

This year our school will participate in the Great American SpellCheck.

Here's how it works: Your child studies 50 spelling words and collects pledges from family and friends for every word that he or she spells correctly on the Great American Spell-Check 50-word test. Your child improves his or her spelling skills and our school enjoys the financial benefits!

Our goal is to raise \$5,000 for maintenance and purchase of sound and lighting equipment for live productions on the CTK stage, projects done in our Broadcast Studio, and additional classroom necessities.

Here is the Great American Spell-Check fund-raising timeline:

- **Thursday, January 5th through Friday, January 20th, 2012:** Students study words appearing on their Great American SpellCheck Study Words sheets. Also, students collect pledges from family and friends.
- **Wednesday January 18th, 2012:** Students must return pledge sheets to their Homeroom Teacher.
- **Friday, January 20th, 2012:** Your student's classroom teacher will proctor the Great American SpellCheck.
- **Monday, January 23rd, 2012:** Your student's teacher will send home the student's graded test and pledge form.
- **Friday, February 3rd, 2012:** This is the deadline for supporters to return their pledged funds.
- **Friday, February 24th, 2012:** This is the day when we announce the top fund-raising class that will win a Dress Down Day and Pizza Party!!!

We ask that you:

- Help your child learn to correctly spell the 50 Great American Spell-Check study words.
- Indicate your level of support on the Great American SpellCheck Pledge Form (attached), and ask family and friends to make pledges.
- Ensure that your child returns the pledge form to their classroom teacher by Wednesday, January 18th, two days before the test. See Attached for more info.
