SCHOOL SUPPLY CART COORDINATORS NEEDED

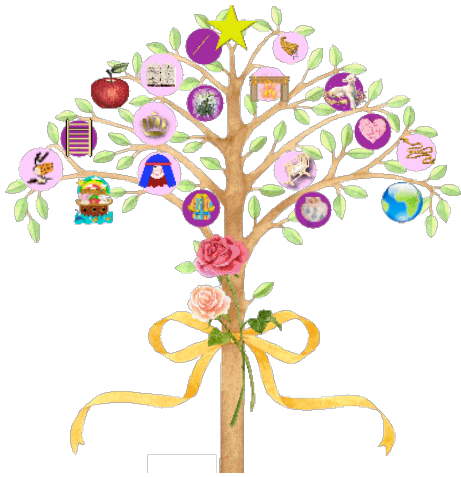
PTO is looking for 1 or more adults to help manage (or co-manage) our new

Most important for your consideration: The deadline for a Charitable IRA rollover has been extended to December 31, 2011.

To Contribute Through the "Charitable IRA Rollover":

- **You must be at least 70 1/2 years old.**
- **The maximum amount transferable per individual in a calendar year is \$100,000.**
- **The gift must be an outright gift that would normally be considered fully deductible.**
- **The funds must be distributed directly from your plan administrator to CTK School.**
- **The funds must be from a Traditional or Roth IRA.**
- **This opportunity is available until December 31, 2011.**
